


The overall population in the CentrOpe region is steadily growing; from 2007 to 2017 there was an increase of 5.12 % so that CentrOpe's population recently climbed over the 8 million mark. However, population growth is mainly restricted to the agglomerations around the region's biggest cities Vienna, Bratislava, České Budějovice, Jihlava, and Brno. In peripheral municipalities of CentrOpe there is a – here and there remarkable – loss of population. The most dynamic spot is the twin city Vienna/Bratislava region which is growing together across the borders as can be seen in the map.


