


The overall population in the CentrOPE region is steadily growing; from 2011 to 2021 there was an increase of 5.5 % so that CentrOPE's population stays over the 8 million mark. However, population growth is mainly restricted to the agglomerations around the region's biggest cities Vienna, Bratislava, České Budějovice, Jihlava, and Brno. In peripheral municipalities of CentrOPE there is a – here and there remarkable – loss of population. The most dynamic spot is the twin city Vienna/Bratislava region which is growing together across the borders as can be seen in the map.
