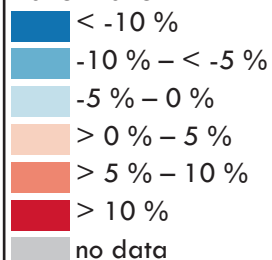


Population development 2015–2025

Relative change of total population

The overall population in the Centrope region is steadily growing; from 2015 to 2025 there was an increase of 7.0 % so that Centrope's population is now near the 8.5 million mark. However, population growth is mainly restricted to the agglomerations around the region's biggest cities Vienna, Bratislava, České Budějovice, Jihlava, and Brno. In peripheral municipalities of Centrope there is a – here and there remarkable – loss of population. The most dynamic spot is the twin city Vienna/Bratislava region which is growing together across the borders as can be seen in the map.
