

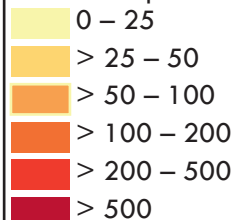
# Population density 2017

## Inhabitants per square kilometre

The highest population density values of the Centrope region (calculated as inhabitants per square kilometre) can be seen in and around the greater agglomeration areas (Vienna and southern surroundings, Bratislava, Brno and Győr regions).

Especially at the boundaries between Lower Austria and the Czech Republic a lower population density can be observed; most probably due to late effects of the Iron Curtain, whereas there are almost no effects of the 1992 established border between the Czech and Slovak Republics visible in terms of population density.
