



Super-aged Centrope?

Percentage of population aged 65 and more, 2017

A super-aged population is defined as having more than 21 % people aged 65 and older.¹ Centrope is currently quite far away from reaching the status of a super-aged region. In 2017, it was at 18 % with a trend for further growth. There were 939 out of 3 507 municipalities (27 %) in the Centrope region with more than 21 % of the population aged 65+ in 2017. The super-aged areas are mainly concentrated in the border areas of Austria towards the Czech Republic and in the Austrian province of Burgenland, also in the Semmering and Lilienfeld areas (Southwest of Lower Austria).
