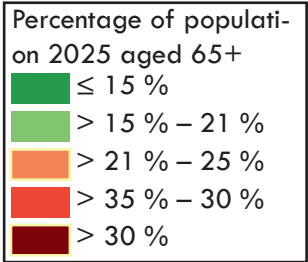


A super-aged population is defined as having more than 21 % people aged 65 and older.¹ Centrope is currently on the way to reaching the status of a super-aged region. In 2025, it was at 47 % with a trend for further growth.

The super-aged areas are mainly concentrated in the border areas of Austria towards the Czech Republic and in the Austrian province of Burgenland, also in the Semmering and Lilienfeld areas (Southwest of Lower Austria). The Slovak parts of the region have a remarkably lower ratio of older population.
