

In this map we take a look how Centrale's population aged 65 and older developed between the years 2008 and 2017. The overall trend shows an increase of population aged 65 and older. The most remarkable increase of elderly people takes place in the Czech area of the Centrale region with an average increase rate of 30 % where as the Centrale region's average increase is 20 %. Also Slovakia's population aged 65 and older is rapidly increasing. Hungary's increase rates are moderate and Austria show the slowest increase of its elderly population.

Change of population aged 65+ from 2008 to 2017 (percentage)

- [Green] decrease > 15 %
- [Light Green] decrease 5 – 15 %
- [White] minor changes (-5 to +5 %)
- [Orange] increase 5 – 15 %
- [Red] increase > 15 %
