

# Ageing of Centrale's population

## Change of proportion aged 65+, 2012–2022


The overall trend shows an increase of population aged 65 and older. The most remarkable increase of elderly people takes place in the Czech and Slovak areas of the Centrale region with an average increase rate of 4.6 percentage points whereas the Centrale region's average increase is 2.7 percentage points. The west of Lower Austria, Vienna, and the Hungarian part of Centrale have several municipalities showing a decrease of population aged 65+.
