The old age dependency ratio shows the relation between population aged 65 older and population in labour force age (15 to 64). The indicator measures the proportion of people retired to the economically active population. High values can be seen in the north and south of Lower Austria and in Burgenland as well as in the northern Czech part of Centrope whereas the Vienna and the Eastern parts of Centrope show a lower old age dependency ratio with the smallest average values in the Slovak part of Centrope.
