


The economic dependency ratio shows the relationship between persons in dependent age (0–14 and 65+) and persons in potential labour force age. High values can, for example, lead to burdens in social security and/or education expenses.

Vienna and the Hungarian and Slovak parts of CentrOPE are below the region's average of 51, especially in Trnavský kraj, whereas Lower Austria, Burgenland, and the Czech Republic values above average.

Relation between dependent ages 0-14/65+ and labour force age population


Economic dependency ratio<sup>1</sup> 2020 (population aged 0-14 and 65+ divided by population aged 15-64)
