

Economic dependency ratio 2021

Relation between dependent ages 0-14/65+ and labour force age population

The economic dependency ratio shows the relationship between persons in dependent age (0–14 and 65+) and persons in potential labour force age. High values can, for example, lead to burdens in social security and/or education expenses.

Vienna and the Hungarian and Slovak parts of Centrope are below the region's average of 52, especially in Trnavský kraj, whereas Lower Austria, Burgenland, and the Czech Republic values above average.
