


The economic dependency ratio shows the relationship between persons in dependent age (0–14 and 65+) and persons in potential labour force age. High values can, for example, lead to burdens in social security and/or education expenses.

Vienna and the Slovak region Trnavský are significantly below the region's average of 52, whereas Lower Austria, Burgenland, and the Czech Republic show values above the Centrale region's average.


## Relation between dependent ages 0-14/65+ and labour force age population
