

The economic dependency ratio shows the relationship between persons in dependent age (0–14 and 65+) and persons in potential labour force age. High values can, for example, lead to burdens in social security and/or education expenses.

Vienna, the Hungarian county Győr-Moson-Sopron and the Slovak Trnavský region are below the region's average of 53.3, whereas Lower Austria, Burgenland, and the Czech Republic show values above average.
