


The change of working age population (people between 15 and 64 years of age) from 2008 to 2017 shows the highest increases in the central area of CentrOpe (Vienna and surroundings, Bratislava and surroundings, northern Burgenland). In the southern border regions of the Czech Republic the working age population is decreasing.

With regard to the values per country, the working age the Austrian part of CentrOpe is the only one with rising numbers, putting Vienna clearly on top with +12 %. The value for the whole CentrOpe region is balanced (+1 %).
