


The unemployment rate is an economic indicator stating the relationship between unemployed population and the whole economically active population. The map shows high values in the southern area of the Czech part of the CentrOpe region; also Slovakia has higher values in greater distance to the capital city Bratislava. The lowest unemployment rates can be observed in Burgenland and the west of Lower Austria, both counties are significantly below the CentrOpe average value of 9 %.
