

Inbound commuting 2011

Ratio of inbound commuting and resident population

The inbound commuter ratio indicates how many people enter a municipality to reach their place of work compared to the population living in this municipality.

High values are mainly shown in municipalities with a large number of jobs (e. g. due to big companies, big industrial areas or for similar reasons) and smaller number of inhabitants (for instance because of lacking attractiveness to live near a cluster of heavy industry).

Some municipalities are highlighted in yellow colour because they have more commuters coming in than people living there.
